Friendly Reminder - Fatima Statue Pick-up

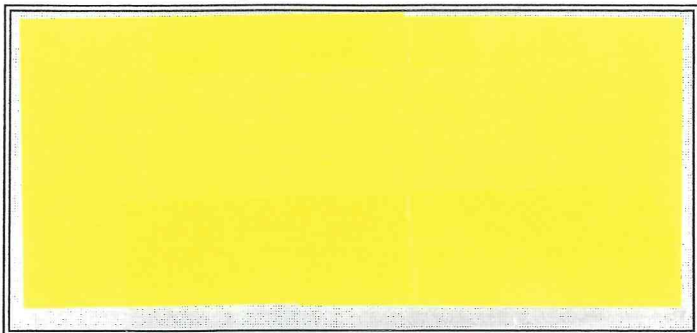

How Do I Become a Catholic?
