- Adults who have never been baptized
- Adults who have been baptized in another Christian tradition
- Adults who have been baptized Catholic & received no other sacraments

Adults prepare for initiation through a process of prayer, rituals, reflection on the Word of God, and teachings of the Church. The program will begin in the Fall and culminate with the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation at Easter time.
