The Wellington Catholic District School Board will be accepting Registrations for Kindergarten at our schools beginning **January 6th, 2020**.

Kindergarten Eligibility:

- must be four years of age on or before December 31, 2020 to attend Junior Kindergarten
- must be five years of age on or before December 31, 2020 to attend Senior Kindergarten.

Please bring:

- child's birth certificate
- a parent or child's Baptismal certificate
- custody parents (if applicable)
- proof of address
- proof of tax support for families new to the system (i.e. most recent tax bill)

Please note: Students currently attending a Wellington Catholic Junior Kindergarten program are **NOT REQUIRED** to register For Senior Kindergarten. 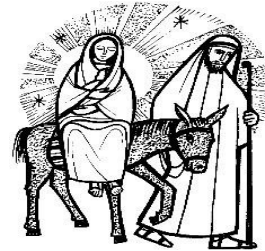
