Kindergarten Eligibility:

- must be four years of age on or before December 31, 2020 to attend Junior Kindergarten
- must be five years of age on or before December 31, 2020 to attend Senior Kindergarten.

- Please bring:**
- child's birth certificate
  - a parent or child's Baptismal certificate
  - custody parents (if applicable)
  - proof of address
  - proof of tax support for families new to the system (i.e. most recent tax bill)

**Please note:** Students currently attending a Wellington Catholic Junior Kindergarten program are **NOT REQUIRED** to register For Senior Kindergarten.
