#### **Resumption of Sunday Mass**

On Monday, June 8<sup>th</sup> Premier Ford announced that Churches in the Province of Ontario can re-open at 30% of capacity. We are delighted that we can resume our celebrations with the People of God participating in person. We want to ensure that we can re-open safely with **necessary health precautions.** 

#### **Dispensation from Obligation**

Bishop Crosby has announced that Catholics in the Diocese of Hamilton are dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass until further notice.

#### **Seating Capacity**

The 30% capacity for us means approximately 120 people. Certain pews have been blocked to help with physical distancing. Members of the same household may sit together. Others should maintain physical distance. Standing is to be avoided. Once we have reached 30% capacity latecomers will be invited to attend another Mass.

#### **Music & Ministries**

The hymnbooks and missals have been removed. Our cantor will lead us at all Masses, the music will be by memory. Our Parish choir will not resume until further notice. One Minister of the Word will proclaim the Scripture readings.

Please open your hand wide to allow the priest to drop the host in your hand to help prevent any contact. Wait for hospitality ministers to direct one row at a time.

#### **Offertory Envelopes**

There will be no collection during mass. Ushers will be at the exits with long handled baskets for your offertory envelopes.

#### Departure at the end of the Mass

Please follow the directions of our hospitality team members who will invite your departure by pew. Please enter & leave the Church with social distance in mind, and strive not to engage in conversation with friends as you leave until temporary measures are lifted. Ushers will be at the exits with long handled baskets for your offertory envelopes.

#### **Masks and Gloves**

Parishioners are encouraged to wear a mask while at Mass. You may carefully remove it in order to receive Holy Communion in your hand, by unhooking it from one ear. Gloves will be provided to those who assist with the cleaning of the Church after each Mass.
