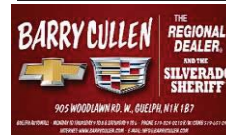

With the Virgin Mother, beg the Lord to liberate the world from every form of pandemic.

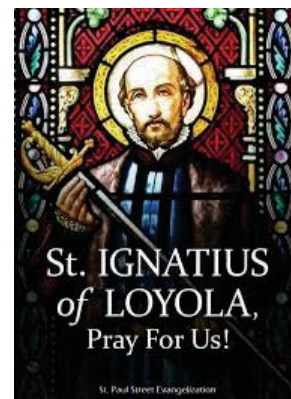
