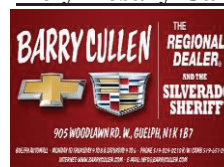

Message of His Holiness Pope Francis for the 107th World Day of Migrants and Refugees 2021

World Day of Migrants and Refugees

“Pope Francis highlights the importance of inclusiveness and fraternity in his 2021 Message for the World Day of Migrants and Refugees, stressing that an ever wider “we” will help renew the human family, build a future of justice and peace, and ensure that no one is left behind. The 107th World Day of Migrants and Refugees, Pope Francis explained that in the Encyclical **Fratelli tutti**, he expressed a concern and a hope that once this health crisis passes, “we will think no longer in terms of ‘them’ and ‘those’, but only ‘us.’” Annually, the World Day for Migrants and Refugees is the last Sunday of September. It is a day set aside to express concern and show solidarity for different vulnerable people on the move; to pray for them as they face many challenges and increase awareness about the opportunities that migration offers. This year, it will be commemorated on September 26th.”
