Nzumbu, is a Jesuit and specialist in conflict minerals, supply chain, due diligence, and corporate social responsibility of mining companies. His expertise extends to renewable energy technology, especially in the areas of energy storage, and transition technologies. He is a PhD student at UQAM (Montreal). He holds several master's degrees: in governance and public policy of natural resources; in international affairs: economics, politics, and business law; and in Ignatian leadership. Fr.
